



## ***Your card looks beautiful!***

Here's how to finish it up. This download has two versions of your card, a jpg file and a PDF.

Open the .jpg in any graphics application and print it out. You can fill in the tag off-computer and write about your imaginary gift. You also can print out clip art and stick it onto the card, to show what you'd like to give. A good place to find art is Pixabay.com, which has public domain photos and illustrations free to print.

The PDF version of your card has text boxes you can fill in on the computer. Open the PDF in Acrobat Reader®, Preview®, or any application in which you can fill in a PDF form. Fill in the tag with the name of the person the gift is for, and your name. Then decide what might be in the box. Be creative about your imaginary gift. It could be hugs and kisses, or good luck, or something wild like a trip to the moon! Or it could be something practical, like washing the dishes for a month.

When you are finished, save your work. You can send the PDF version by email, or you can print out the card and give it as a gift! Then try wrapping another imaginary gift.
