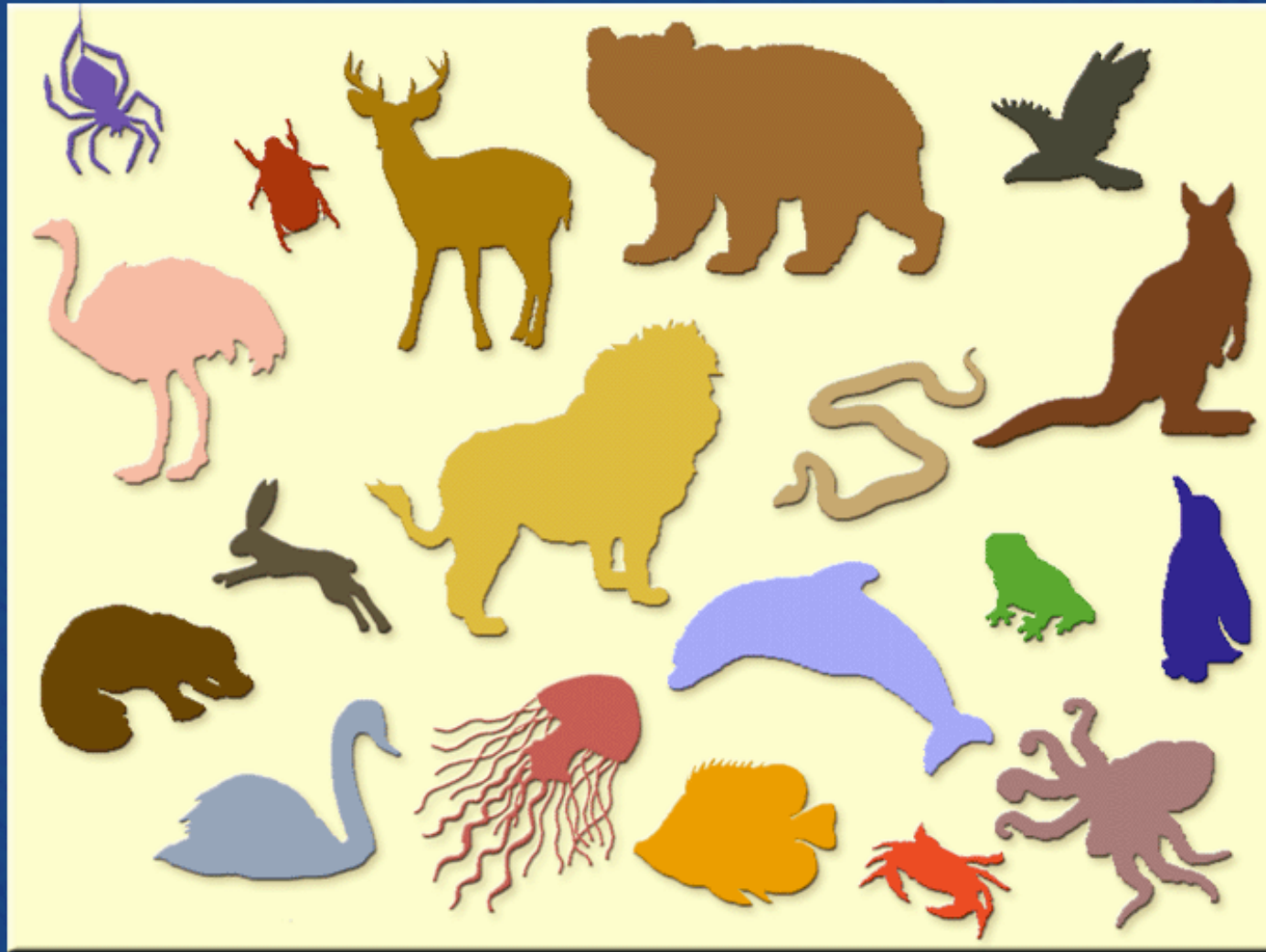


# What I Like About Animals

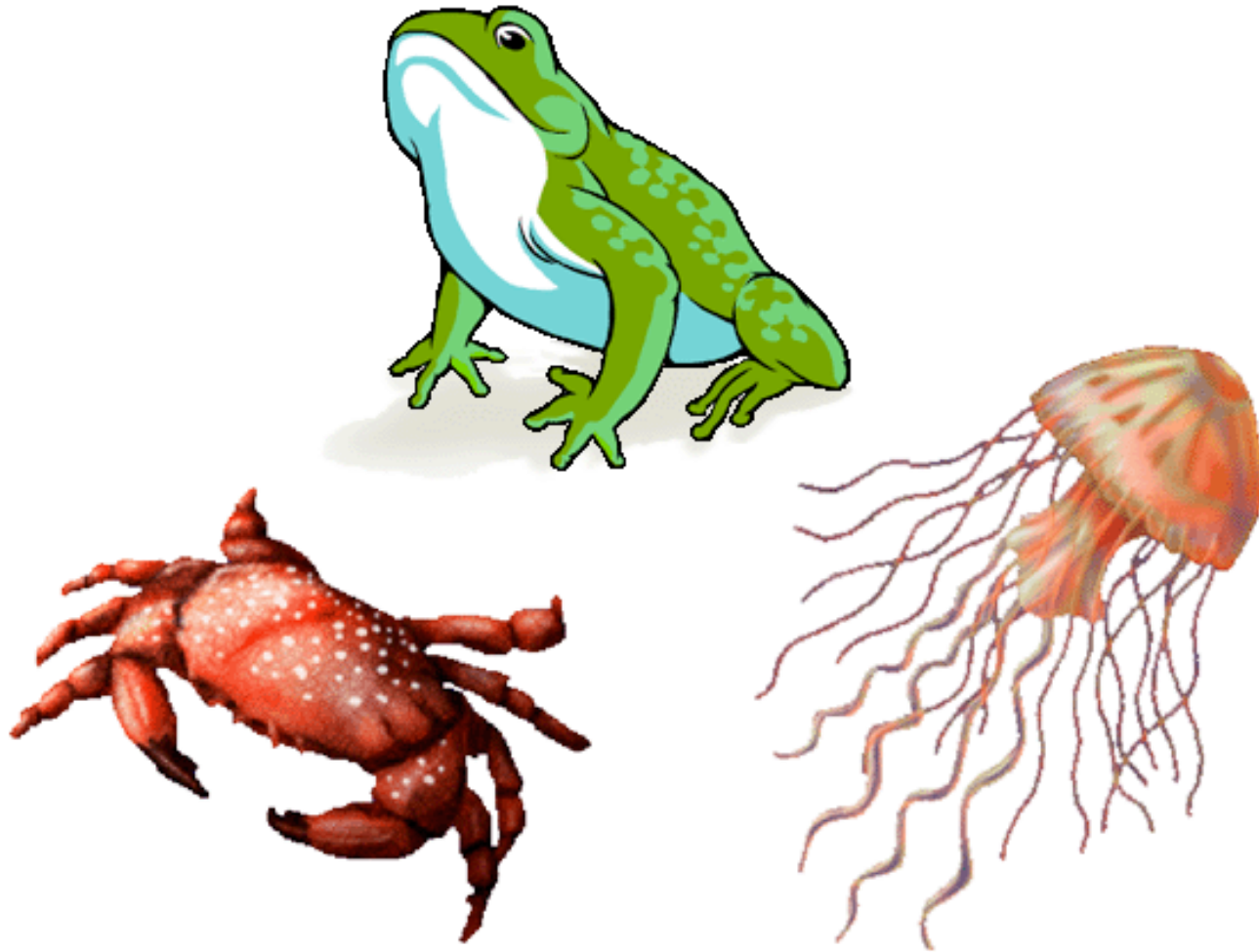

Guess what I like best about animals!



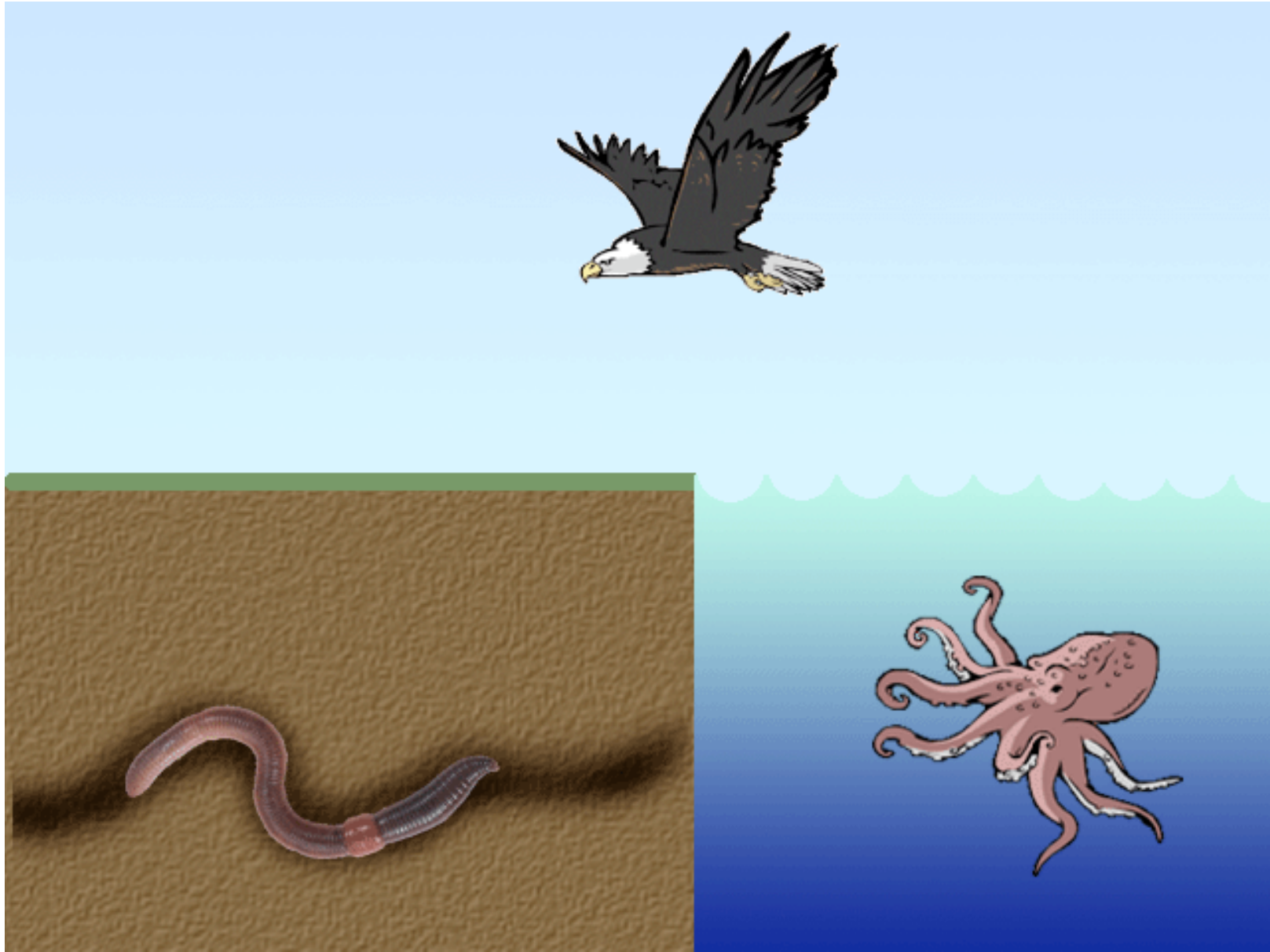
A lion has fur, a swan has feathers, and a fish has scales.



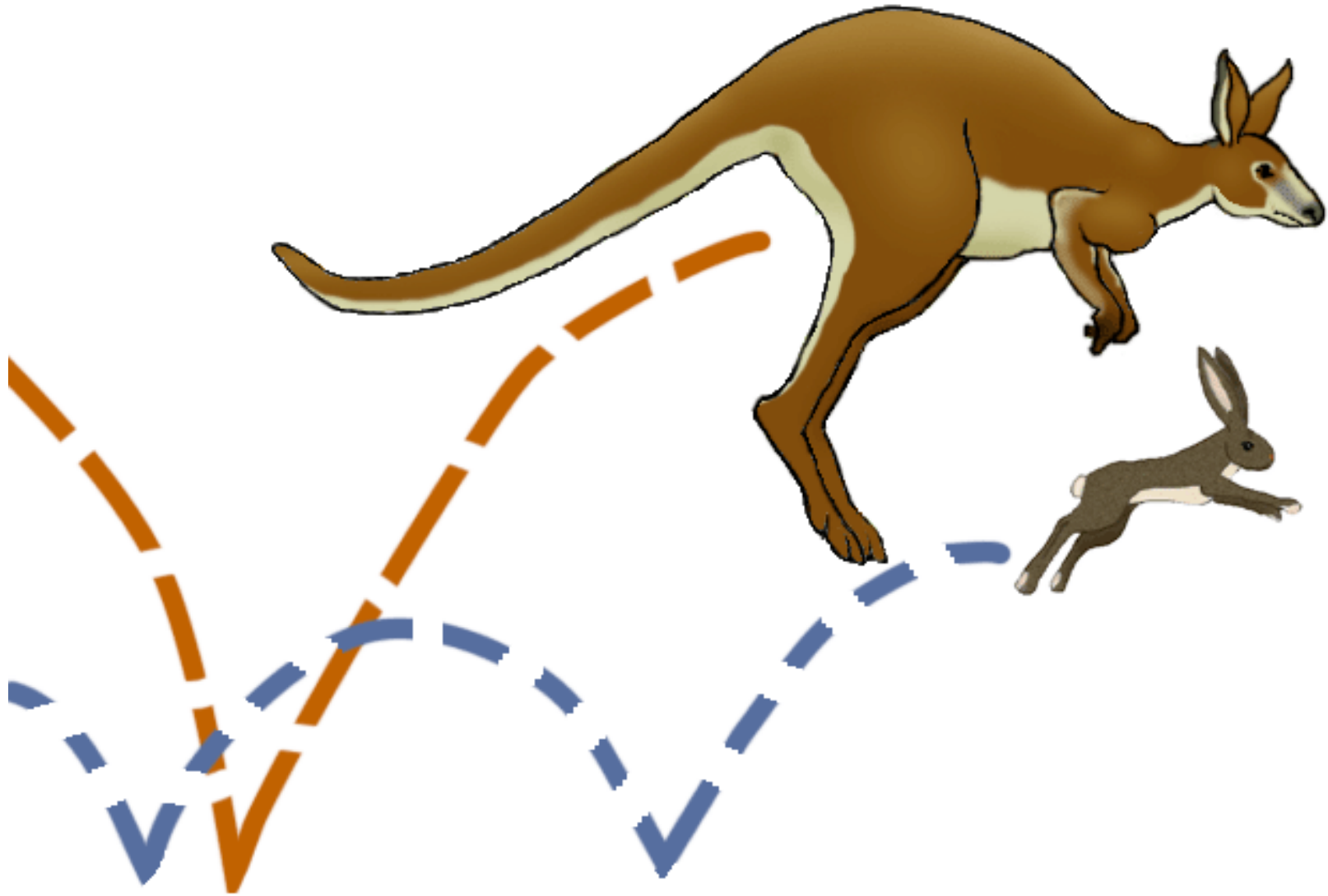
A crab is hard on the outside, a frog is soft on the outside with hard bones inside, and a jellyfish is soft all over.



A deer has four legs, a beetle has six legs, a spider has eight legs, and snakes have no legs at all!



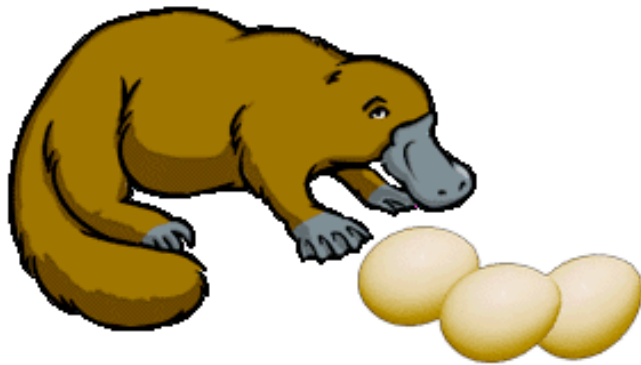
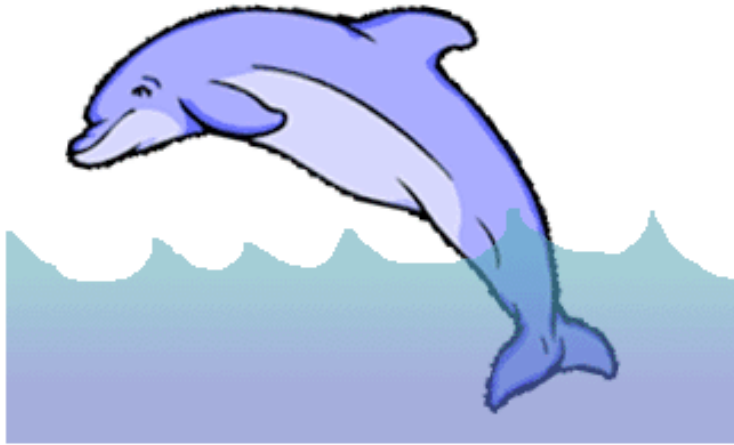
An eagle flies through the air, an octopus lives underwater, and an earthworm lives underground.
