Let's count how many birds come to the feeder.



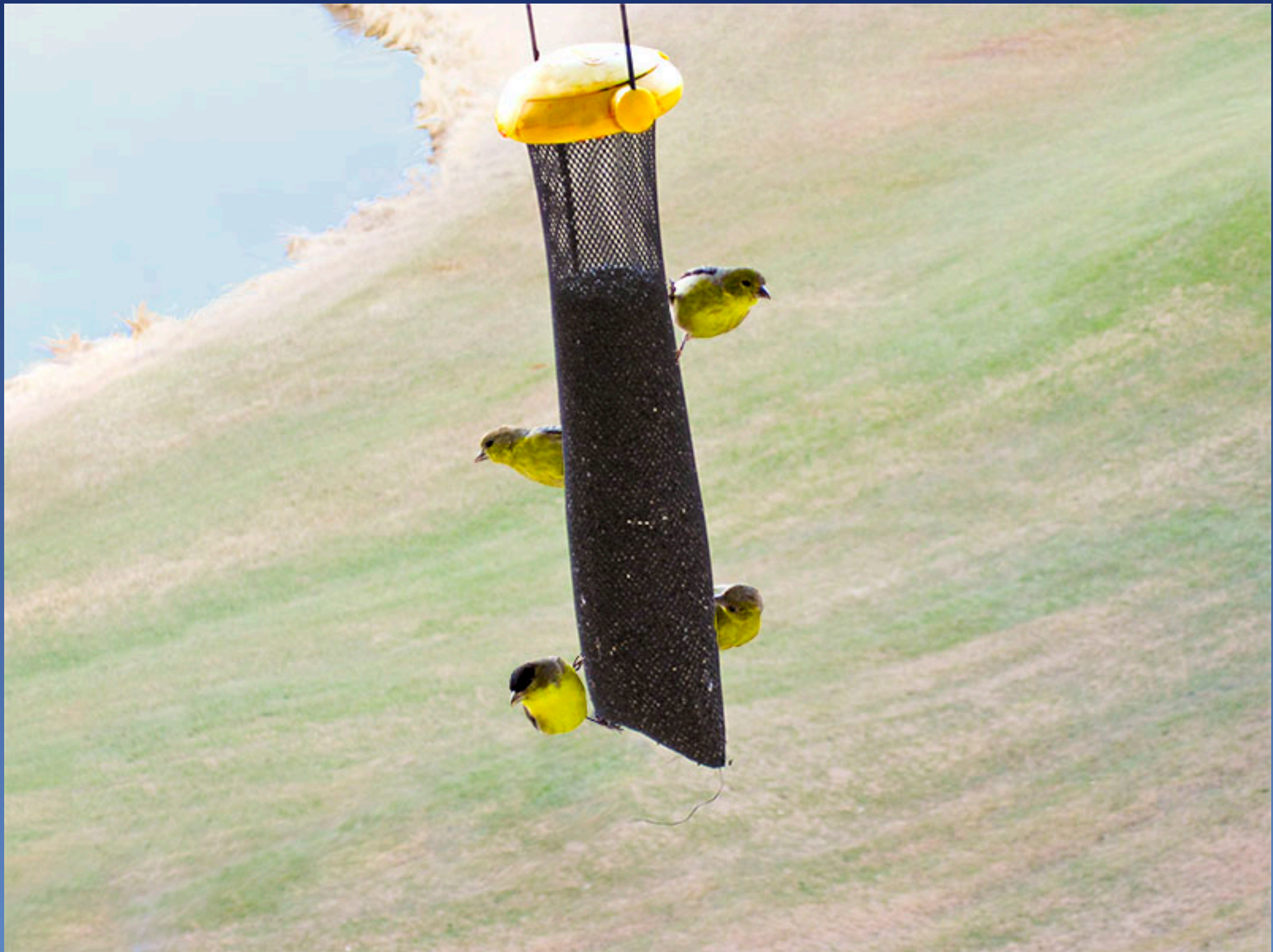
One bird.
