Printable Jigsaw Puzzles

This PDF file is a set of jigsaw puzzles made from photos in the **Treasure Hunt!** activity set. There are two each puzzles of 12 and 20 pieces. The scenes were rendered in various versions of Vue® and, sadly, they only exist in my imagination.

- 1. For each puzzle, print out the page on US letter size paper in **landscape** orientation, or use Acrobat Reader®'s auto portrait/landscape setting. Choose current page or a range of pages. Tip: If you use photo paper, the colors of the puzzles will be richer.
- 2. Mount each puzzle sheet on a stiff backing (cardboard, flexible plastic, etc).
- 3. Carefully cut around each puzzle piece. It's easier to start by cutting apart strips of pieces, then doing the detail cutting with something like an x-acto® knife.
- 4. You may wish to coat the pieces with a clear layer to make them more durable. Be sure to test to make sure the ink does not run. Also be sure that the coating is safe for kids.


